Rezoning Amendment – 7390 Sheridan West Forest Service Road 7:00 pm October 17, 2017 at the Interlakes Community Hall

The Cariboo Regional District (CRD) has received an application to amend South Cariboo Area Zoning Bylaw No. 3501, 1999 by rezoning the property described below:

Bylaw No. 5092

District Lot 7904, Lillooet District, from Rural 2 (RR 2) zone to Lakeshore Residential 2 (RL 2) zone (minimum lot size – 0.8 ha in RL 2) (maximum density - 2 lots)

Purpose for Rezoning: To subdivide into two lots for residential use.

The subject property is located at 7390 Sheridan West Forest Service Road, as shown on the sketch plan below, and is owned by Irene Astley.
